**PMKVY TO TRIBAL DOMINATED AREA**

**†\*376. SHRI KANAKMAL KATARA:**

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:-

- (a) the number of tribal people who have been provided employment after impart of training under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) in tribal dominated area including Banswara-Dungarpur of Rajasthan during the last three years;
- (b) the number of applications received by the Government for setting up of training centres in tribal areas of the State and the number of such centres set up;
- (c) the steps taken to make employment oriented professional training easier to the tribal communities and the district-wise details thereof; and
- (d) the amount of funds released and the percentage thereof utilized for skill development of tribal communities in Rajasthan including Banswara-Dungarpur during the last three years?

**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (A) TO (D) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. †\*376 TO BE ANSWERED ON 27.03.2023 ASKED BY SHRI KANAKMAL KATARA REGARDING PMKVY TO TRIBAL DOMINATED AREA**

(a) The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) has been implementing Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) for imparting skill development training through Short-Term Training (STT) and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) to youth including tribal candidates across all States/ Union Territories (UTs) including Rajasthan. All the candidates certified under STT were facilitated for job opportunities, while RPL was not linked with placements as it recognized the existing skills of candidate. Under STT component of PMKVY, 44,142 ST candidates have been reported placed in the tribal dominated areas (identified by Ministry of Tribal Affairs) during the last three years (2019-20 to 2021-22). 490 and 463 ST candidates have been reported placed in the district Banswara and Dungarpur of Rajasthan respectively.

(b) Training Centres (TCs) under PMKVY are set up through a free, fair and transparent process. On receipt of applications, selection is made on merit and TCs are affiliated and accredited. In the tribal dominated areas, total 1,281, 1,751 and 825 TCs were set up under PMKVY 1.0, PMKVY 2.0 and PMKVY 3.0 respectively.

(c) PMKVY was a demand driven scheme with bottom-up approach for identification and mapping of job roles. The training had been imparted in Sector Skill Councils and District Skill Committee (DSC) identified job roles based on the local and industry requirement. Further, the training centres were opened in tribal areas and other incentives as per Common Norms like one-time placements travel cost and post placement stipend were also extended to tribal communities. In addition, Rozgar Melas and Apprenticeship Melas were also organized at district and regional level for providing placement opportunities to the candidates.

(d) For the skill development of the youth including tribal communities in the State of Rajasthan, Rs. 210.20 crore had been utilized under Centrally Sponsored Centrally Managed (CSCM) component of PMKVY and 12 crore and Rs. 18.76 Crore has been released and utilized respectively under the Centrally Sponsored State Managed (CSSM) component of PMKVY during the last three years (2019-20 to 2020-21). However, Rs. 14.19 crore was released to State of Rajasthan during the Financial Year 2016-17 under CSSM component of PMKVY.

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
